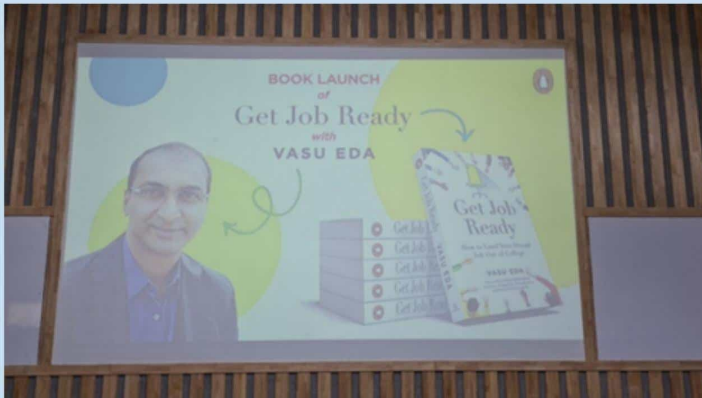

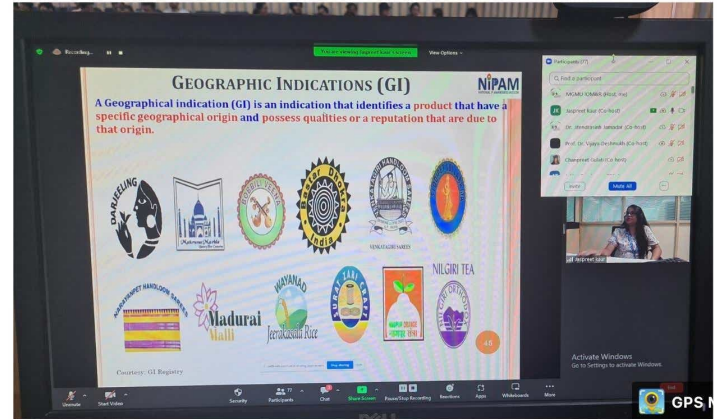
Trekking Activity

The Message Of A Sailor

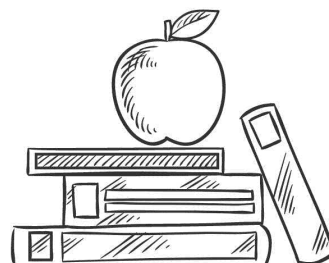
Misty wind blows
