Instructions for the Conduct of Common Entrance Tests, for Admission to UG/PG Programs (other than B.Tech., M.Tech., B.P.A., M.P.A.) offered by MGM University for AY 2023-24

1. UG/PG Common Entrance Test (CETs) will be conducted for admission to UG/PG programs offered by MGM University, Aurangabad. MGMU-CET is to be planned as per following schedule :

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6. **Conduct.** The CETs will be conducted in the online mode in the respective Institutes.
7. A candidate will be required to attempt 60 MCQs in 90 minutes. Each question will carry one Mark. There will be no negative marking.

9. **Schedule and Shifts.** The tests will be conducted as per the program issued by the coordinator in consultation with ERP. Time slots for test will be given by considering the number of candidates available for the subjects.
10. **Late login.** Candidate can log in late up to 15 mins only from the start time. Thereafter, they will not be allowed to appear in the test. This will be mentioned in the test instructions given in the e-admit card Exam. Centres will display the seating plan at the entrance of the examination centre prominently and provide directions to the students to reach their exam hall.
11. **Instructions.** Detailed instructions will be given to the candidates for logging in, for establishing their identity, attempting the questions & submitting answer in time etc by ERP cell. These instructions will be given in the e-admit cards of the students. Video link of demo will be emailed to candidates along with the e-admit card. This will be the responsibility of ERP Cell.
12. **Issue of the Score Card.** The candidates will be issued their score card with of the CET after the result is approved by the Hon'ble Vice-chancellor.
13. **Merit List.** For making the merit list, 50 percent weightage each will be given to the score of CET and the marks of the qualifying exam.
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
